Our bodies are like the planet – naked and vulnerable in the face of fossil-fuelled aggression ...

In solidarity with cyclists all over the planet, York hosts its very own **World Naked Bike Ride** for the seventh year running. The WNBR is a colourful protest against unsustainable oil usage and the infestation of our roads by cars. Our lack of clothing highlights our vulnerability as cyclists, and celebrates what we all have in common: our vehicle is human-powered.

The Ride is actually clothing-optional – fully nude or as bare as you dare. We decorate our bodies and bikes with messages of opposition to oil dependency and car culture. Use body paint, flowers, feathers, attach flags and placards – get creative!

Turn up between 3 and 4 pm for a beautiful protest – we assemble 50 metres south of Millennium Bridge on the Fulford side. Bring bells, whistles and a bag or pannier for your clothes. The ride sets off soon after 4 pm. All cyclists welcome.
