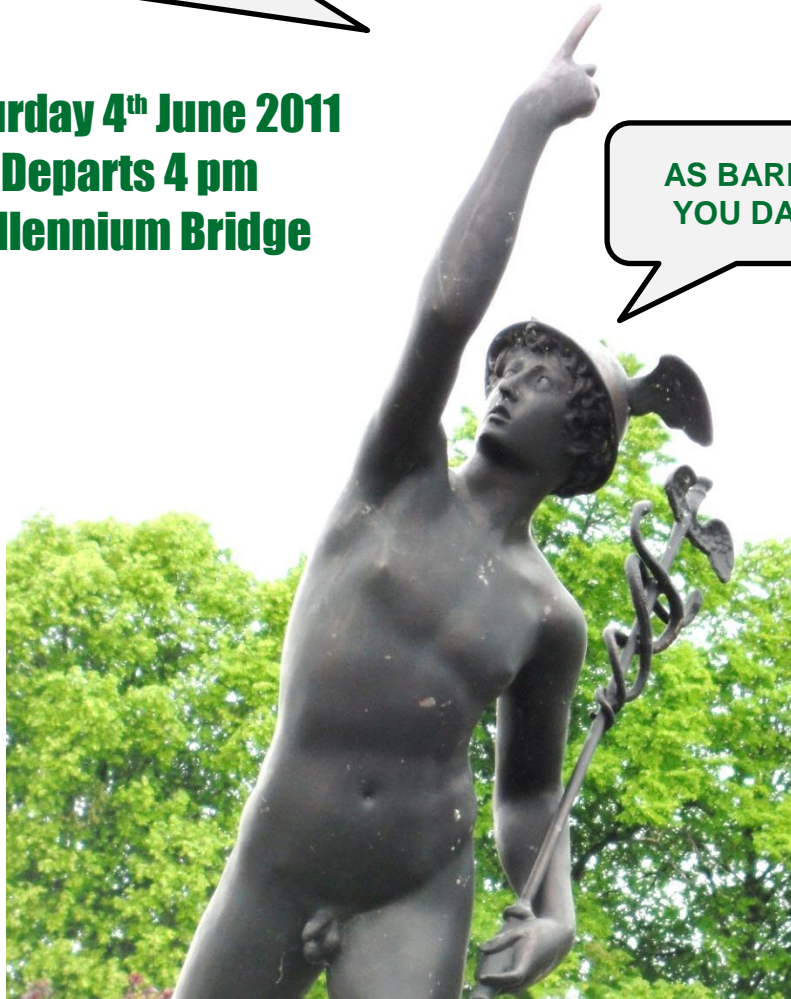


This way to the Seventh York World Naked Bike Ride
